

Process for ordering Botulism antitoxin (BAT) and diphtheria antitoxin (DAT).

Notify the local Public Health Department before ordering BAT or DAT. In hours see <u>HPSC: Who to notify</u> for contact details, out of hours, contact ambulance control.

- 1. Each hospital site should already have a National Cold Chain Service (NCCS) account setup (usually hospital pharmacy department).
- 2. **To order in hours**: the account holder emails NCCS (<u>vaccines@udd.ie</u>) and requests the specific antitoxin and correct dosage required
- 3. **To order out of hours**: Regional Public Health on-call should be contacted to discuss. Ordering of BAT or DAT out of hours is mediated through the National Health Protection Office On-Call consultant who can arrange emergency delivery.
