



# Report of the profile of COVID-19 cases in healthcare workers in Ireland

# week 32 (02/08/2020-08/08/2020) - week 45 (01/11/2020-07/11/2020)

Report prepared by HPSC on 10/11/2020

This report includes data on healthcare worker (HCW) cases of COVID-19 (all case classification – confirmed, probably, possible) notified to the national infectious disease surveillance system (CIDR) from week 32 (02/08/2020 - 08/08/2020) to week 45 (01/11/2020 - 07/11/2020). Appendix A provides a summary of HCW cases of COVID-19 since the pandemic commenced in Ireland from week 10 (01/03/2020- 07/03/2020) to week 45 (01/11/2020 -07/11/2020). CIDR is a dynamic information system and data are continuously validated and updated.

#### Healthcare worker definition

Healthcare worker status is determined both by self-classification and workplace. The definition includes anyone who self-identifies as a HCW irrespective of where they work. In addition, all staff that work in any healthcare facility (includes cleaners, household staff etc.) are classified as HCWs. The category includes healthcare workers employed both by public and private providers.



From week 32 (02/08/2020-08/08/2020) to week 45 (01/11/2020-07/11/2020), there was a total of 39,293 COVID-19 cases reported to the national surveillance system (CIDR), 2,437 (6.2%) were healthcare workers (HCWs).

For the period from week 32 (02/08/2020-08/08/2020) to week 45 (01/11/2020-07/11/2020), the median age of HCW COVID-19 cases is 39 years (range 17-76 years). The number of female cases is

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disproportionately high (78.0%) among HCW COVID-19 cases compared to non-HCW COVID-19 cases (48.5%), most likely due to some HCW specialities e.g. nursing, being female dominated. The HSE region with the largest proportion of HCW cases is HSE East (42.2%).




Figure 2: Distribution of healthcare worker COVID-19 cases notified to HPSC, by sex and age group, week 32 (02/08/2020-08/08/2020) - week 45 (01/11/2020-07/11/2020), Ireland, (n=2,433) \*

Of the 2,437 HCW COVID-19 cases notified to HPSC between week 32 and week 45, 322 cases were reported in week 45.


