COVID-19 Outbreaks in Workplaces

In total, 237 COVID-19 outbreaks in workplaces¹ have been notified up to midnight on 31/10/2020

- Workplace outbreaks involved a variety of workplaces and facilities
- 84 COVID-19 notified outbreaks involved various food/beverage related industries, of which 52 were in meat/poultry/fish processing plants in all HSE Areas (Table 2), and five were in mushroom farms/facilities (four in HSE Northeast and one in HSE Southeast)
- In week 44, two outbreaks occurred in meat/poultry/fish processing plants

¹ Workplace outbreaks exclude the following workplaces hospitals, residential facilities, hotels, public houses, retail outlets, and other settings (outbreaks in GP practices and outbreaks associated with home carers). These are reported under those headings in the full weekly outbreak report.

COVID-19 Outbreaks Vulnerable Populations

This brief overview of COVID-19 outbreaks in vulnerable populations/settings only includes outbreaks involving the Roma community, Irish Traveller community, outbreaks in Direct Provision Centres, facilities for the homeless/those with addiction issues and prisons notified up to midnight on 31/10/2020 (Table 3). COVID-19 outbreaks and cases are continuously validated/updated on Ireland's National Computerised Infectious Disease Reporting System (CIDR).

There were 5 new outbreaks reported in vulnerable populations during week 44

- One was in a prison
- One was in a Direct Provision Centre
- Three outbreaks were among members of the Irish Traveller community
