Summary Immunisation Uptake Statistics for Ireland by Local Health Office



A report by the Health Protection Surveillance Centre

The immunisation uptake statistics presented in this summary document relate to children 12 and 24 months of age in Quarter 2-2007 and who have received three doses of vaccines against diphtheria (D_3), pertussis (P_3), tetanus (T_3), *Haemophilus influenzae* type b (Hib_3), polio ($Polio_3$) and meningococcal group C ($MenC_3$), one booster dose of *Haemophilus influenzae* type b vaccine after 12 months of age (Hib_b : uptake at 24 months only), one dose of vaccine against measles, mumps and rubella (MMR_1 ; uptake at 24 months only) and one dose of BCG vaccine (BCG: uptake at 12 months only). These statistics therefore relate to uptake in the cohorts born between 01/04/2006 & 30/06/2006 and 01/04/2005 & 30/06/2005.

The immunisation uptake statistics for Quarter 2-2007 are presented in this summary document by Local Health Office (LHO) area.




Figure 1. D₃ immunisation uptake rates (%) by LHO, in those 12 months of age in Quarter 2 2007, in (A) Ireland and (B) Dublin. Please see Appendix 1 to translate codes for LHO areas. While North Lee and South Lee are two separate LHOs their combined immunisation uptake data are reported here (NSL).




Figure 2. D₃ immunisation uptake rates (%) by LHO, in those 24 months of age in Quarter 2 2007, in (A) Ireland and (B) Dublin. Please see Appendix 1 to translate codes for LHO areas. While North Lee and South Lee are two separate LHOs their combined immunisation uptake data are reported here (NSL).

D3 immunisation uptake rates, in those 12 and 24 months of age in Quarter 2-2007, are mapped by LHO in figures 1 and 2. Immunisation uptake rates of P₃, T₃, Hib₃, Polio₃ and MenC₃ are not mapped here by LHO because their rates are very similar to D₃ uptake rates (see table 1).




Figure 3. MMR₁ immunisation uptake rates (%) by LHO, in those 24 months of age in Quarter 2 2007, in (A) Ireland and (B) Dublin. Please see Appendix 1 to translate codes for LHO areas. Please note while North Lee and South Lee are two separate LHOs their combined immunisation uptake data are reported here (NSL).

MMR₁ immunisation uptake rates, in those 24 months of age in Quarter 2-2007, are mapped by LHO in figure 3.




Figure 4. Hib_b immunisation uptake rates (%) by LHO, in those 24 months of age in Quarter 2 2007, in (A) Ireland and (B) Dublin. Please note the Hib_b immunisation uptake rate reported relates to children in this birth cohort who received one dose of Hib after 12 months of age, as this was the format most HSE-Areas could extract the data. The HSE-E (Dublin, KE/WW and WW) and HSE-W (G, MO and RN) rates are probably underestimates as only the number of children who had received four doses of Hib (Hib₄) were included in the calculation (as requested). Please see Appendix 1 to translate codes for LHO areas. Note while North Lee and South Lee are two separate LHOs their combined immunisation uptake data are reported here (NSL).

Hib_b immunisation uptake rates, in those 24 months of age in Quarter 2-2007, are mapped by LHO in figure 4.

Immunisation uptake rates for all antigens, in those 12 and 24 months of age in Quarter 2-2007, are reported by LHO in tables 1 and 2.
