

## **RECOMMENDED LOCAL OUTBREAK CONTROL TEAM MEMBERSHIP**

The Medical Officer for Health (MOH) / Director of Public Health (DPH) is responsible for establishing a local outbreak control team (LOCT) to co-ordinate the local / regional response to the diagnosis of a case of Viral Haemorrhagic Fever (VHF) in Ireland.

- National Ambulance Service (NAS)
