

^{*}Exposure within 2 metres of a confirmed or probable case of plague

^{*}Aircraft/ship exposure within 2 metres of a probable or confirmed plague case in the last 7 days. A risk assessment to identify contacts (including passengers or crew) of the case should be carried

^{*}Contact with the following items without appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE):

^{*}Contact with a sick animal/flea bite in a plague affected area
